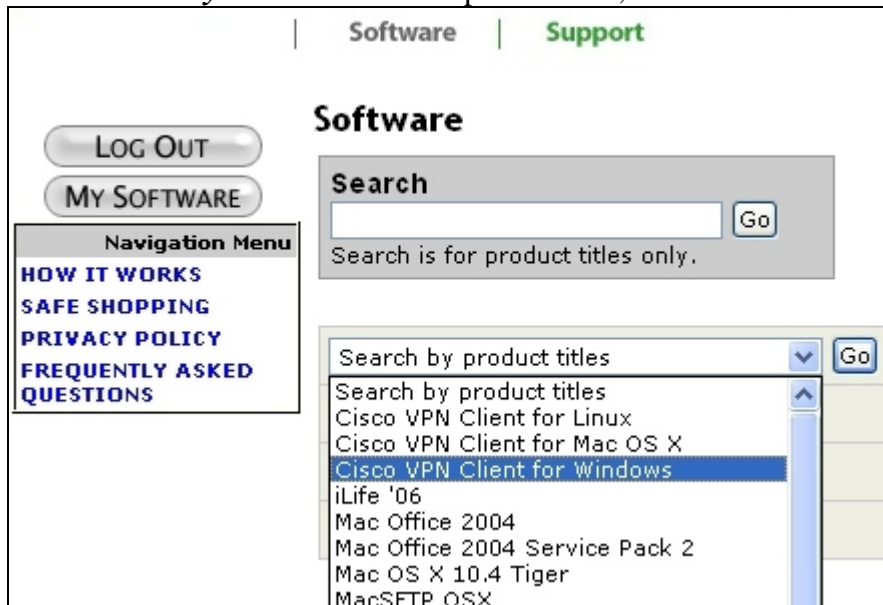


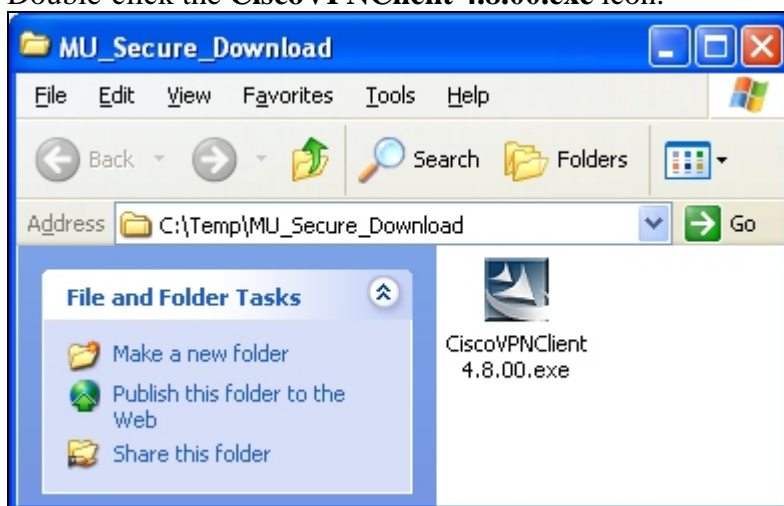

**Installing the Cisco VPN Client to a Personal Laptop**  
**Windows XP**

1. Open your internet browser and go to <http://doit.missouri.edu/software/mu-ready.html>
2. Click the **Software Distribution Site** link in the “Availability” section near the top of the page.
3. Click the grey **Log In** button, enter your **PawPrint & Password**, then click **OK**.
4. Click the green **Software** link at the top of the Software Distribution webpage.
5. In the **Search by Product Titles** drop-down box, select **Cisco VPN Client for Windows**, then click **Go**.

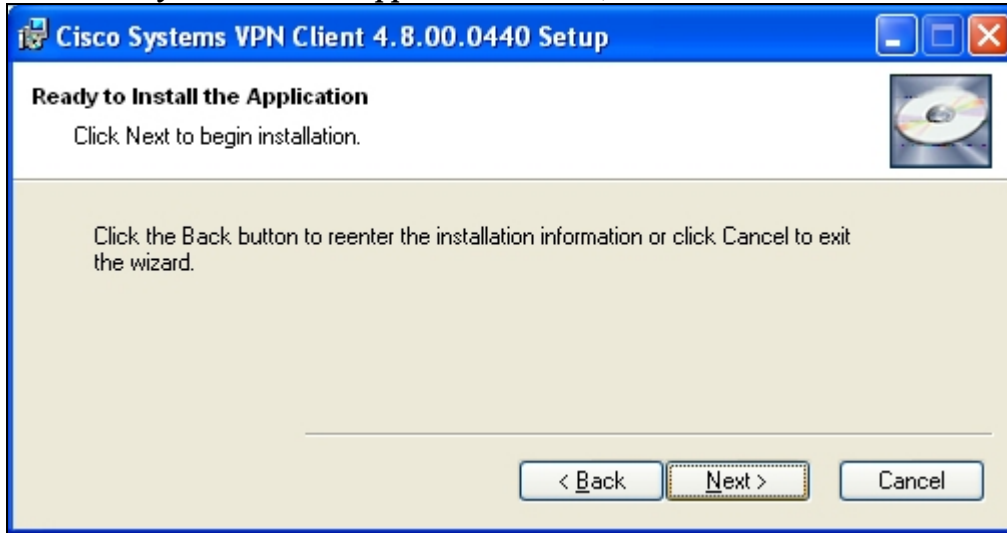


6. Click the orange **Get It** button, then click **Download Software**.
7. In the **File Download** window, click **Run**.
8. In the **Internet Explorer – Security Warning** window, click **Run** again.
9. Accept the default download location (C:\Temp) by clicking **Continue**.
10. Once the file has completed downloading, click **Launch Install**.
11. Double-click the **CiscoVPNClient 4.8.00.exe** icon.



12. In the **Cisco Systems VPN Client Setup** wizard, click **Next**.

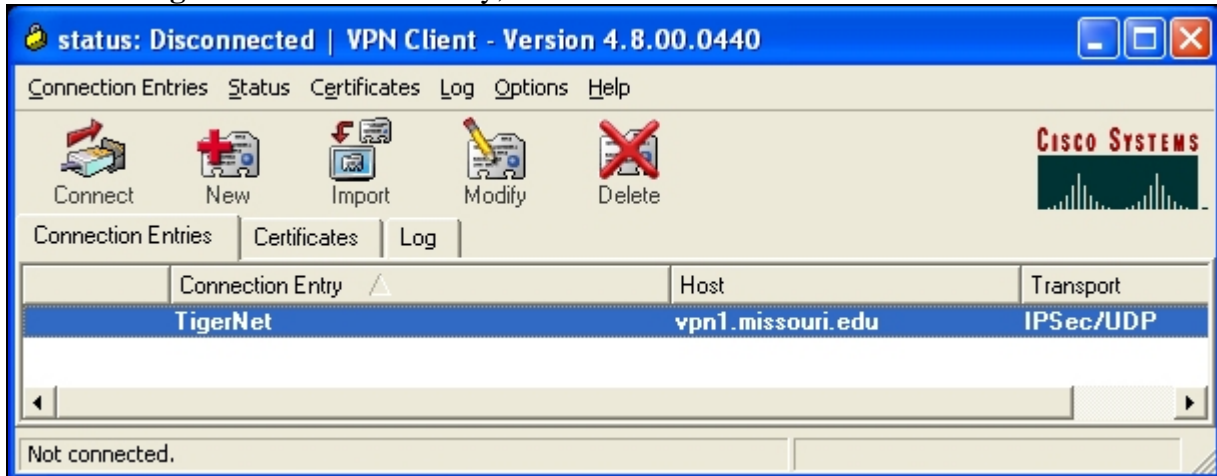
13. Accept the license agreement by clicking **Next**.
14. Accept the default destination folder by clicking **Next**.
15. At the *Ready to Install the Application* screen, click **Next**.



16. At the *Cisco VPN Client has been successfully installed* screen, click **Finish**.
17. If prompted, please reboot your system.

### Instructions for running the Cisco VPN Client

1. Click **Start > All Programs > Cisco Systems VPN Client > VPN Client**.
2. Select the **TigerNet** Connection Entry, then click the **Connect** button.



3. At the *User Authentication* window, enter your **Pawprint & Password**, then click **OK**.
- ✓ After a few seconds, the VPN Client will connect and a lock icon will appear in your system tray.
