MU SCHOOL OF LAW SEEKS COMPETITION JUDGES

COLUMBIA, MO – The University of Missouri School of Law’s Board of Advocates (BOA) seeks attorneys to volunteer as judges for its upcoming regional arbitration competition.

On November 21-22, BOA will sponsor a regional arbitration competition at the School of Law. The group seeks individuals with arbitration experience in particular, but attorneys specializing in other areas are welcome. Students will compete in teams of four, with two attorneys and two clients on a team. Two teams compete in each room and three judges are assigned in each room. Instructions will be provided for judges. Schools from five states are competing in this competition.

All BOA judges receive **free continuing legal education credit** in the State of Missouri. Actual credit varies, but ranges between 4.8 and 6 hours.
